

A Note on Projects & Series

There are five (5) projects that spanned across a two year period from about 2015-2017 shown in the Personal Work>Projects>Long Term Projects [HK] Section of the Website: You can access that [here](#).

My *Project 365* was completed in 2015 and involved making, editing, and posting an image everyday for one year. It was very demanding but its an extremely valuable exercise for any photographer, especially beginners. The project allows for unrestricted experimentation and elimination of what you *don't want to do* in photography. You can view those images, in chronological order [here](#):

The One Minute of Life [60 1-second exposure images] was completed between October 2016 and July 2017. This project involved making 60 1-second exposure time images that would add up to one minute of life upon completion. The images in the project are not related, per se, except for the one second exposure time requirement. This project has a specific constraint that forces a deep dive into long exposure photography and resulted in some unexpected and rather delightful pictures.

In more personal work, there are a few Series that are included into the site as well. These include: Pushing People, Pipe Dreams, Birds, Wheels [Moving Urban Images], View from Devil's Peak Yau Tong, and Visual Rhythm. All images were make in Hong Kong from 2015-2017.

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
